## Weightage of Internal Assessment

### For Grade I to IX

1. Periodic Test = 10 Marks
2. Subject Enrichment = 5 Marks
3. Note Book/Portfolio = 5 Marks

75% Attendance is mandatory to appear in the Examination.**
